Zero Carbon Transport Protocol (October 2024):

- The Peruvian government has implemented a protocol aimed at reducing carbon emissions in the transportation sector. The initiative focuses on promoting the use of electric vehicles and modernizing infrastructure for sustainable vehicles in larger cities, such as Lima.

Initiatives to Combat Deforestation in the Peruvian Amazon (September 2024):

- The Peruvian government, together with international organizations, launched a reforestation and satellite monitoring program to curb deforestation in the Amazon. It is program includes strengthening laws against illegal logging and promoting sustainable agricultural practices.

INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL NEWS (JULY-DECEMBER 2024)

Global Agreement for the Protection of the Oceans (July 2024):

At an international event in New York, more than 100 countries signed a historic agreement to protect the oceans and marine biodiversity. The agreement seeks to reduce plastic pollution and protect the marine ecosystems.

- Expected impact: Improve ocean health and reduce plastic pollution globally.

European Union Bans the Use of Single-Use Plastics (September 2024):

The European Union has approved new legislation banning the use of single-use plastics in all its Member States, starting in 2025. This includes products such as straws, cutlery and disposable plates.

- Expected impact: Significant reduction of plastic pollution in Europe and leadership in the fight against global pollution.

New International Agreement to Combat Climate Change (December 2024): At COP30 in Buenos Aires, more than 190 countries signed a global agreement to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and limit global warming to 1.5°C. This agreement includes stricter commitments for industrialized nations and a focus on the transition to renewable energy.



ENVIRONMENTAL NEWS IN THE TEXTILE SECTOR:

LAUNCH OF SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS FOR FASHION IN PERU (AUGUST 2024):

Several Peruvian textile companies have begun incorporating organic fibers and recycled materials into their clothing lines. These initiatives are aimed at reducing plastic use and reducing the carbon footprint of the company textile production.

Expected impact: Promote more sustainable fashion in the country and reduce textile waste.

ALLIANCES FOR CLOTHING RECYCLING (DECEMBER 2024):

Peruvian companies in the textile sector have formed alliances with companies of recycling to transform used garments into new pieces of clothing or industrial materials.

Expected impact: Reduce textile waste and promote the circular economy within the fashion industry.



MANUFACTURING CLOTHES FROM ORGANIC WASTE (SEPTEMBER 2024):

Innovative initiatives in the textile sector are using organic waste such as seaweed, mushrooms, and fruit peels to create sustainable fabrics. Companies such as Algaeing and MycoTex are developing biodegradable textiles from these materials, reducing the use of non-renewable resources and the environmental footprint of textile production.
